

Professor Ujjain Bhattacharya



Dr. Ujjayan Bhattacharya is a Professor of History at Vidyasagar University. He has specialised in the history of revenue institutions and agrarian agencies in eighteenth century. He carried out a project on the history of tribes, communities and local history, entitled “Communities and Local History: A Study in the Processes of Community Formation in South-Western Bengal (Mid 19th century to 1947)” under the auspices of Naulana Abul Kalam Azad Institute of Asian Studies in 2006-08. His broader interest includes agrarian communities and caste, agrarian economy, local history and development of administrative structures during pre-colonial and early colonial administration. He has also researched on the history of water management and embankments, and, during his tenure as a faculty in Goa University he worked on the history of the Portuguese in Bengal.
