PROSPECTUS (2016-2017)

For Admission to Post-Graduate and other Courses

Vidyasagar University started its academic activities during 7th plan period(1985) from the session 1985-1986 following an Act of the State Assembly to cater to the needs of higher education with special emphasis on the all-round development of the rural areas of the agro-based districts of Midnapore. The geographical area covered by this University is quite underdeveloped and that demands special attention on human resource development to improve socio-economic condition of the people of this region and so course have been designed so as to be helpful for achieving this goal.

The University started with six Post-Graduate Departments under Arts & Commerce and Science Faculty for the session 1985-1986 and in each designed course special stress was given on regional needs. Subsequently in 1989 & 1990, nine more PG. Course were added and here also special attention and weightage were duly given to the need of the locality and so various environmental requirements like Forestry, Fisheries, Health and Nutritional needs of the people and the technological requirements for industrial developments of the region were largely incorporated in the syllabi. In addition to fifteen PG Courses, Masters degree in Geography in 1995, M.C.A. in 1998, Microbiology and Electronics in 2001, PGLDT (late MLT, now Bio-Medical Laboratory Science & Management) and Masters degree in Computer Science in 2002, Remote Sensing & GIS and Aquaculture Management & Technology (new named as Fishery Science in 2014) in 2003 have been started. From 2005, Masters degree in Sanskrit, Sociology and Bio-Medical Laboratory Science & Management (a UGC innovative Programme) have been started. From 2006-2007, two-year M.B.A. Course has been started. All the above courses are running in Vidyasagar University Campus.

Post-Graduate Courses in Computer Science, Physics and Zoology were introduced at Panskura Banamali College, Midnapore College and Raja N.L. Khan Women's College respectively from the session 2004-05. Also M.A in Bengali at Khargapur College and M.Sc in Chemistry at Jhargram Raj College are running from the session 2005-2006. From the session 2006-2007 M.A. in Bengali at Tamralipta Mahavidyalaya, M.A. in Sanskrit Rabindra Satabarshiki Mahavidyalaya, Ghatal, M.Sc in Bio-Chemistry, M.Sc in Bio-Technology and M.Sc in Nutrition & Dietetics have been introduced off campus under VU. M.S.W Course and 1-year Diploma Course in Psychological Counselling are running at Vidyasagar School of Social Work, DD/18/4/1, Salt Lake City, Kolkata-700 064. from the academic year 1994-1995 and 2005-2006 respectively. M.Phil Programme in Political Science was introduced in the academic year 2008-09. 1-year Diploma Course in Office Automation and Internet Technologies has been started from the session 2008-09. M.S.W. course is also running at AMIK Institute of Management Science and Technology. 3&4 Kabiguru Sarani, City Centre, Durgapur. One year PG. Diploma Course in Applied Computer Science, Diploma Course in Advance Hardware and Networking Administration (6 months) and Certificate Course in Basic and Advanced Java (3 months) are

running in V.U. in collaboration with CMC. One year Diploma Course in Office Automation and Internet Technologies is running in the University. M.A. in Santali and M.Sc in Nutrition& Dietetics have been started from the session 2009-2010&2010-11 respectively in the university. M.A in Hindi has been started from the session 2011-12.M.Sc in Clinical Nutrition& Dietetics and PG Diploma in Quality Control and Assurance in Microbial Technology have been started from the session 2012-13. Procedure for Application:

The candidates will fill up the Application Form only through online portal (<http://onlineadmission.vidyasagar.ac.in>). After successful completion of all the steps (e.g. filling up the personal details, academic details, uploading photo and signature), the candidate will pay Rs.150/-(Rupees one hundred fifty) only through online mode of payment (credit/debit card, net banking etc). The applicant should send the printed version of the Application Form, self attested photocopies of all testimonials to the Secretary, Faculty Councils for Post Graduate

Studies on or before the last date of submission mentioned in the Admission Notification by post or courier. The same may be dropped in the 'Drop Box' kept in the Office of the Secretary, Faculty Councils for Post Graduate Studies.

Following documents are to be attached with the application:

- (a) Self attested photo copies of all the Mark sheets of Examination passed, University Registration Certificate and a copy of the Passport Size coloured photograph affixed on the box of the Form.
- (b) Self attested photo copy of the Admit Card/ Certificate of H.S. or equivalent /Madhyamik as evidence of the date of birth.
- (c) Self attested photo copy of SC/ ST/ OBC-A/ OBC-B/Persons with Disability(PWD) certificate issued by the appropriate authority, if claimed quota.
- (d) Self attested photo copies of the Certificate of Games & Sports/ Cultural Competition (International/ National/ State in the last two years), if claimed quota.
- (e) Self attested photo copy of the BPL Certificate of the parents issued by the appropriate authority, if claimed for concession of tuition fees.
- (f) Migration Certificate (for other university candidates only) must be submitted within two months from the date of admission.

Application form, if not properly filled in and accompanied with attested copies of the documents as stated above, is liable to be cancelled.

All candidates are required to produce all original Certificates, Mark Sheets and testimonials for verification at the time of Counselling and admission. Candidate is to be present himself / herself for proper verification of the photograph affixed with the application form.

SELECTION PROCESS FOR ADMISSION

For the Students of Vidyasagar university

- (a) As per order of the Govt. of West Bengal 60% of total seats in each subject will be reserved for the students of V.U. and 40% seats will be available for Open Competition.
- (b) Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. Marks obtained in Honours will be the sole criteria. Honours candidates of the current session and the immediately preceding session will be considered equally. In the case of equal marks in Honours, total marks / percentage of marks of immediately preceding Examination are to be taken into account for ranking.
- (c) Quota for SC/ ST will be considered as per Govt. order 906 Edn / Estt dated 18.09.1997. Number of seats(SC-22% , ST-6%) will be calculated and considered separately for 60% seats of V.U. students and 40% seats for Open Competition. Fraction of 0.5% or more will be rounded to the next whole number. In case of non-availability of students of SC category, the seats reserved for SC may be converted to ST Category and vice-versa.
- (d) 3% of each category will be reserved for Persons with Disability(PWD) candidates. Merit list will be prepared on the percentage of PWD. In case of non-availability of PWD candidate, the seat reserved for PWD will be converted to General Category.
- (e)) Prize holders at International/National/State representation in the last two years will be considered for sports quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Competition/ Inter College Athletic Meet organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. The sports

events are Football, Volleyball, Athletic, Joga, Khoko, Kabadi, Chess, Table Tennis. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.

- (f) Prize holders in the International/National/State meet in the last two years will be considered for Cultural quota provided that he/she participated in the Inter College Cultural Competition organized by our university in his/her tenure in UG level. A committee will be constituted to assess the performance of the applicants in the respective field.
- (g) Normally 60% seats will be for the students of the Vidyasagar University and 40% seats for other Open Competition. This 60% and 40% may be relaxed in case of non-availability of the applicants in either category.

For Open Competition

(i) 40% Seats in each department will be for Open Competition.

(ii) The students of other universities will have to appear at Entrance Test. The minimum marks for appearing at Entrance Test is as follows:

Arts & Commerce : 45% marks in Hons. (for Gen. Candidates)

: 40% marks in Hons. (for SC / ST./OBC-A/OBC-B/ PWD Candidates)

Science : 50% marks in Hons. (for Gen. Candidates)

: 45% marks in Hons. (for SC / ST/ OBC-A/OBC-B /PWD Candidates)

(iii) The students of V.U. may appear at the Entrance Test & they have to secure the minimum marks as specified above.

(h) Questions will be of MCQ pattern; Full Marks- 50; Total no. of Questions-50, Time- One hour.

(i) Questions will be set in English, except in Bengali, Hindi, Sanskrit and Santali

Women's Studies Centre

Objectives:

Women's Studies Centre aims to promote study, research, documentation & publications, training and consultancy on issues related to women with an objective to support women from all

strata of society specially from rural South- Bengal to understand the inner potentials, and also intends to provide a flourishing interdisciplinary environment for research and allied activities on a wide range of Women's issue.

Activities of the Women's Studies Centre (2015-2016)

Women's Studies Centre organized many seminars, training and awareness programmes during the academic year 2015-2016. Some of which are given below:-

1. A lecture on "***Women Medical Care and the Colonial State***" on 31st July 2015 at Vidyasagar University.
2. A lecture on "***Indian Army Rape Us-Kristevas Herethics & the Semiotic Bodies of Mothers of Manorama***" on 13th August, 2015 at Vidyasagar University.
3. A training programme on "***Discourse on Human Rights Focusing Women Issues***" on 17th December, 2015 at Vidyasagar University.
4. A Winter School Programme during 5-25(21 days) January, 2016 on '***Gender, Women and Society: Debates and Developments***' was held in which 29 participants came from different colleges of the university and more than 40 resource persons from different parts of India visited the centre and delivered lectures to the course participants .
5. International Women's Day was celebrated on 8th March, 2016 in collaboration with NSS cell, Vidyasagar University involving students and teachers of the university. Students participated in different activities through paintings, recitations and debate relating to women's issues.

M.Phil. Programme in Women's Studies

The centre is planning to organize two year long M.Phil programme on Women's Studies from this year. Details of which will be announced soon.

Placement Activity

Under the guidance of Dean of Students' Welfare, the placement cell consisting of different placement coordinators of respective departments invites various organizations to conduct campus recruitment for the interested students of VU. This cell facilitates all the interested students of VU to get employment through on campus or off campus. A partial list of the organizations who recruited our students are: Wipro, TCS, Pradan, HDFC Bank, Lintex Co.Ltd., ICICI Bank, SELVEL, Haldia Petro Chemicals, Future Group, Deson Steel, etc.

Hostel Accommodation

There are four hostels- two for girls and two for boys, in the University Campus. Total 600 students (300 in Girls' Hostel and 300 in Boys' Hostel) can be accommodated in these hostels.

Hostel accommodation is provided to the selected students based on the distance between their place of residence and Vidyasagar University, parents' income and past academic results. Soon after the admission, interested bona-fide students of the University may submit their applications to the Dean of Students' Welfare, for the accommodation in hostels. The prescribed fees to be deposited in the cash counter, by the shortlisted candidates after announcement of final list of the selected candidates.

Multi-gym Facility

To keep the students physically and mentally fit, the university is extending Multi-gym facility separately for boys and girls on payment basis. These two Multi-gyms are kept opened four hours in the morning and four hours in the evening. Multi-gyms are well equipped with state of the art facilities and every one can visit the Multi-gym and use properly for their physical fitness. Interested bona-fide students may submit the application to the Sports Officer for membership.

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

(A) Counselling and admission will be held on same day. On the date of Counselling the students /Parents/Guardians have to produce the original Certificates/testimonials for verification. Date and time will be notified at the bottom of the Merit Lists. (B) After the admission, the vacancy, if any, will be filled up from the Merit List through counselling. Date, time and venue will be notified later on the Notice Board. (C) Admission to PG and other courses will be closed on the 15th effective teaching day with effect from the date of commencement of classes. (D) If any student remains absent from the classes for 10 (ten) consecutive teaching days without valid reasons and without prior intimation to the respective Head of the Department or the Secretary, Faculty Councils for PG. Studies his/her admission will be treated as cancelled and the vacancy will be filled up from the Merit Listed candidates on merit. From the date of commencement of classes absence is counted.(E) The admitted students are to attend at least 75% of the total classes held in all Semesters; otherwise, he/she will not be allowed to fill up his/her form for examination.(F) Applicants are to follow the notices all the time. No intimation of any kind will be sent to the individual at any stage.(G) Hostel Accommodation : There are three Hostels – one for Boys and two for Girls- in the University campus. Boys' Hostel and Girls' Hostels accommodate 186 students and 240 students respectively. Hostel accommodation is provided to the selected students depending on the distance between their place of residence and Vidyasagar University. Preference is given to the students coming from other State or remote places .Admitted students soon after admission may apply to the Dean, Students' Welfare for the accommodation of Hostel.(H) **The students of other universities who will get admitted have to submit the 'Migration Certificate' within three months from the date of admission, otherwise he / she will not be allowed to appear at the final examination of the Semester-I.** (I) Fees once paid by a student for admission to PG or other courses will not be refunded under any circumstances.(j)The student will not indulge in any act ragging. If he/she is found guilty of any aspect of ragging, he/she will be punished as per provisions of the UGC regulations and/or as per law in force.(k) For admission to different courses, an SC or ST candidate getting admission should have obtained

in the previous examination; qualifying marks not lower by more than 25% of the marks obtained by the last candidate of the General category. In case of OBC-A and OBC-B the candidates getting admission should have obtained in the previous examination, qualifying marks not lower by more than 10% from the marks obtained by the last candidate of the General category. In any case, if a candidate obtained marks lower than the minimum qualifying marks prescribed by the university / appropriate authority for admission to the relevant courses, he/she will not be eligible for admission.(1) Two seats under Supernumerary Quota will be made available to the students of Jammu & Kashmir who seek admission.
