

Information for the Authors

Submission of Manuscript: The Journal is devoted to original research articles. These are papers of the highest quality that present a clear and insightful exposition of significant aspects of contemporary research in various fields of sciences. Authors are encouraged to submit original work that has neither appeared in, nor is under review by other journals. A reasonable amount of compactness is essential and readability of papers is considered important. The language of publication is English only. The journal maintains strict refereeing procedures through its editorial policies in order to publish papers of only high quality. Authors must have responsibility of the contents of their papers. Papers may be submitted by the authors in either of following two ways. Author(s) must provide a list of THREE possible reviewers' names with full addresses containing e-mail addresses.

Authors may submit their manuscripts electronically in DOC file format to the following address:

Style of Manuscript: All manuscripts should be submitted in English. To avoid delay all submissions should be prepared according to the following guidelines:

- (1) **The form:** The manuscripts must be typed in single spaced. The use of 11 pt fonts is required and all pages are to be numbered.
- (2) **The typing area:** Page width 8.5 in, height 11 in; margins: left 1.5 in, right 1.5 in, top 1 in and bottom 1 in.
- (3) **The first page:** It should contain the title, the name of the author(s), an abstract not exceeding 160 words which must contain main facts followed by key words and phrases.
- (4) **The last page:** It should contain the list of references followed by the author's institution with an e-mail address.

(5) **References:** The titles of papers and books should be italic. The reference list should be preceded by a reference number with no square brackets alphabetically (in lexicographic order of the last name). The word REFERENCES should be capitalized and centered above the reference list. These should be styled and punctuated according to the following examples:

1. N. Abramson, Information Theory and Coding, McGraw-Hill, Inc., New York, 1963.
2. A. Rosenfeld, Fuzzy groups, J. Math. Anal. Appl., 35 (1971) 512-517.
3. L.A. Zadeh, Fuzzy sets, Inform and Control, 8 (1965) 338-365.

(6) **Final manuscript:** Authors are encouraged to submit MS-Word versions of their final (accepted) manuscripts on diskette or by email and accompanied by one hard copy of the manuscript. Submitting a typeset file may reduce the publication time significantly.

(7) All figures and tables should be planned to fit the proportions of the printed page 5.2 in x 8.5 in and numbered consecutively with Arabic numerals in the order of appearance in the text. They can be designed by MS-Word. Also all authors are strongly recommended to submit PS or EPS or JPEG files for their figures. The figures should have captions and they numbered serially.

(8) All tables should be designed by MS-Word. The tables should have captions and they numbered serially.

(9) Sections should be in boldface, centered and numbered with Arabic numerals. They should not be capitalized.

(10) Subsections should be in boldface, indent (not centered) and numbered with Arabic numerals. They should not be capitalized.

(11) The Titles, Theorem, Corollary, Proposition, Lemma, Definition and Remark etc. should be in boldface, left-justified and numbered consecutively. The first character of each word should be capitalized and the rest of it should not be capitalized. The contents of these titles except for Remark and Definition must be italic.

(12) The word Proof should be italic and left-justified. "a little box (■)" should be put at the end of Proof.

(13) The final manuscript with JPS format (style) is restricted up to 20 pages. But we do put no restrictions on the invited articles.
