Articles, both a hard copy and a soft copy, are to be sent to the Executive Editor, along with a declaration as attachment that they are not under consideration elsewhere.

They should be Word-processed, double-spaced, and in Times New Roman 14 point (PDF format not acceptable). Articles in Bengali should be Word-compatible. The length should not exceed 8000 words, including endnotes (not footnotes). Reviews should be of a maximum of 1000 words. Abstracts of 100 words and 5 keywords are to be sent along with the contributions. Diagrams, illustrations, and photographs are to be kept to a minimum. Quotations are to be indented to the right when they exceed 35 words.

The following indicative examples may be used for endnotes (please use *Ibid.* and *Op. Cit.* to avoid repetition):

A separate attachment should bear their name(s), institutional affiliation(s), and the title of the article. The first page of the article should have the title only at the top.
