The residential distance certificate to be submitted issued from the (1) District Magistrate, (2) Additional District Magistrate (3) Deputy Magistrate Deputy Collector (4) Sub – Divisional Officer (5) Block Development Officer (6) Superintendent of police, (7) Additional Superintendent of police, (8) Sub-divisional police officer or Deputy Superintendent of police (9) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Deputy Commissioner, Assistant Commissioners or Police commissionerate (10) Judicial Magistrate of any rank or position in the concerned district or Metropolitan locality or Judge/Judicial Officer of the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court or the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India (11) Commissioner, Additional Commissioner, Joint Commissioner, Assistant Commissioner of Municipal Corporation (12) Executive Officer of Municipality (13) Assistant Secretary / equivalent or above in the Secretariat to the Government of West Bengal (including GITA) or central Government (14) Deputy Director or above in the Directorate to the Government of west Bengal or Central Government.
 3. The Attested copy of last qualifying mark sheet is to be submitted.
 4. Cash Receipt of P.G admission course.
 5. Applicant's attested copies of voter card and Aadhar card.
 6. Certificate of Medical fitness.
 7. The selected candidates will have to deposit as 6000/- (Six thousand only) per academic year at the time of admission.
 8. Students are informed to fill correct information and upload all the required documents in PDF format.
 9. Character certificate reporting on the inter-personal/social behavioral pattern of the applicant issued by the institution last attended by the applicant.
 10. At the time of admission additional Anti-Ragging affidavits counter signed by his/her parent/guardians.
