- An Online Executive Training Program on MATLAB had been organised by the Department of Applied Mathematics, Vidyasagar University, from 25th to 27th March 2025.





Broadcast schedule: The programs of 'Betar Vidyasagar' are mainly broadcast in regional languages (Bengali, Saontali) but programs in Hindi, Sanskrit and English are also broadcast. THE COASTAL OBSERVATORY AND OUTREACH CENTRE (COOC)

About the Centre

The Coastal Observatory and Outreach Centre (COOC) of Vidyasagar University is an interdisciplinary centre dedicated to research and education on topics related to the ocean, coast, disasters, and climate change. COOC was officially established during the Ninth Executive Council Meeting of Vidyasagar University, held on May 10, 2023 (its 17th meeting). However, the activities of the centre began earlier, in August 2018, with the establishment of a laboratory-cum-secretariat at Vidyasagar University. The Coastal Station of COOC is located at Meenalay, Digha, in Purba Medinipur District, West Bengal, India. This station was established in collaboration with the Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS) under the Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India, and the Fisheries Department of the Government of West Bengal. Initially, the space for the Coastal Station is provided by the Department of Fisheries, Government of West Bengal.
